I am writing on behalf of the Workplace Conflict Management Section ("Workplace Section") of the Interagency Alternative Dispute Resolution Working Group ("IADRWG"), to make you aware of our community and its resources. The Workplace Section provides guidance on best practices in program development, education, and technical assistance to meet the ADR needs of federal agencies. We work with agencies and departments to enhance their workplace alternative dispute resolution (ADR) programs.

Among the activities of the Workplace Section is the ADR Lunchtime Series (generally held on a bi-monthly basis) at the Department of Energy.
